Qualifications and Experience:

The successful candidate must meet the following criteria to be appointed:

- **Associate Lecturer**
An undergraduate degree which includes mathematics;
Master's degree in Mathematics Education;
Current registration for a PhD;
Evidence of research ability or potential;
Experience in teaching mathematics at school or tertiary level.

OR

- **Lecturer:**
PhD in Mathematics Education;
Evidence of research ability or potential (a publication record would be an advantage);
An undergraduate degree which includes mathematics;
Experience in teaching mathematics at school or tertiary level;
Experience in teaching in Mathematics Education in higher education.

Remuneration: Dependent on qualifications and relevant experience.
